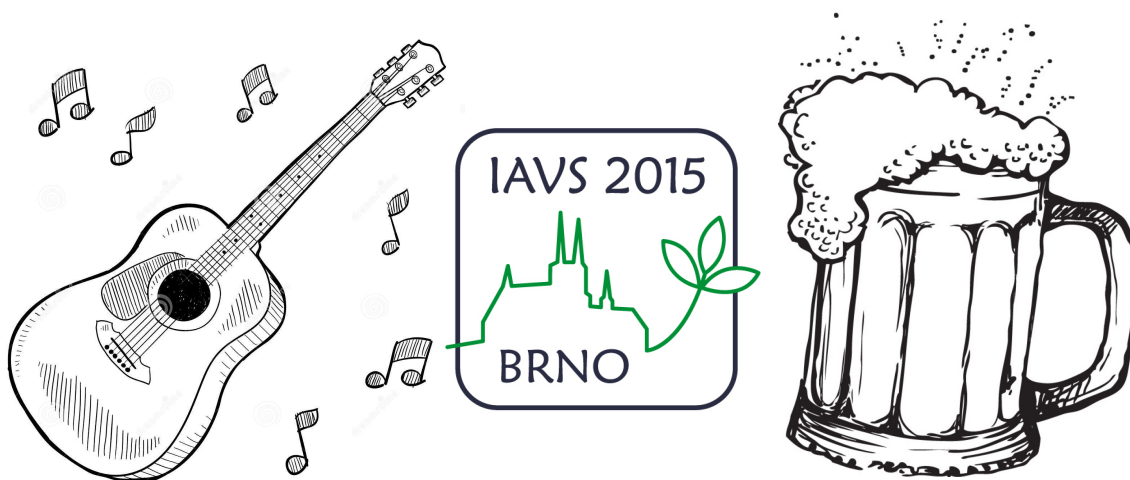


IAVS music jam-pivo session

22 July 2015 - Železná Růže (Iron Rose) pub from 19h



At the 58th IAVS Annual Symposium, similarly to other symposia, there will be an opportunity for students and researchers to get together and play some music, in a kind of acoustic jam session. People who can play any transportable instrument are welcome to bring it to the session and join us for a friendly and relaxed time together. You do not need to be a professional musician but just like to play with others! People who do not play any instrument are welcome anyway to join the event, maybe just to sing with us or drink a good Czech pivo (i.e. “beer”). Few guitars and percussions will be available for those who need them, if it is too inconvenient to bring your own.

This event will be an occasion to socialize after a hopefully nice day on one of the mid-symposium excursions (**Wednesday 22nd July**). A pub, at walking distance from the symposium venue, more specifically the Železná Růže (Iron Rose) pub at Hlinky street 48 (<http://www.zeleznaruze.cz>), has been reserved for the event since 19h (music will probably start a bit later). The aim is not to play high quality music, but to play some Czech and international songs together, in a kind of improvisation acoustic setting. As a matter of fact it is a typical Czech tradition to meet friends in a pub and (try to) play some music together (while drinking some of that good pivo of course). Please notice that you can also have dinner at the pub. But consider that your meal and drinks will have to be paid from your own pocket.
